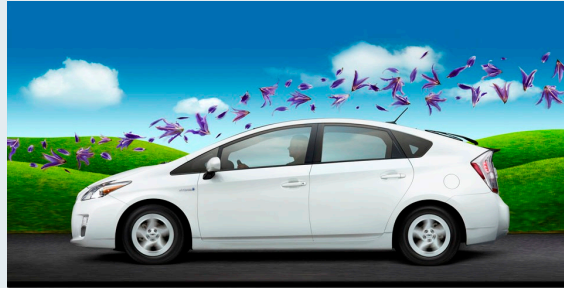

## WARRANTIES

**Basic:** 36 months/36,000 miles (all components other than normal wear and maintenance items).
